Defense Secretary Mark Esper said the administration will continue to talk to lawmakers and coordinate with the Democratic chairman of the House Armed Services Committee about whether to allow more people, including veterans with mental illness, to serve. Esper said Wednesday that lawmakers have raised the issue of allowing more people to join the military since the 1960s. And we’re going to continue to have those conversations,” Esper told reporters at the Pentagon, where he was meeting with Army Gen.
