
East West Colossus Keygen Downloadl REPACK

a good example is the fender rhodes. despite the fact the rhodes has been sampled many times, colossus includes a unique vintage sounding rhodes you wont find anywhere else. colossus includes 15 gigs of new sounds recorded at ocean way studio b (24-bit), a new 2 gig piano recorded in europe, and 15 gigs from the award winning range of quantum leap and eastwest titles (ew/ql symphonic orchestra, ew steinway b piano, ql stormdrum, ql guitar and bass, ql 56 strat, ql hardcore bass, ql ra, ql brass, ql voices of the apocalypse), all newly programmed with superior sound quality. with colossus installed and authorised, you're now ready to get to work. as with the kompakt sample library, colossus is supplied with 36 complete song tracks and a standalone 'main' track, for mix and master duties. the song tracks are all named after the instruments sampled to create the sounds, whilst the main track is named after the style of music that the sampled instrument is best suited to, for example, "gnawa style". the sounds in colossus are organised into 'branches', which are essentially folders. if you drag the folder containing the sounds that you wish to use into the kompakt 'sound library' window, they will appear within the appropriate folder. whilst kompakt allows you to load a large variety of external sample libraries, colossus is an internal library only. obviously, there are two issues to consider. first, how do you get all the samples to load into the kompakt library? the colossus cd-rom contains eight dvds with a total of 15 gigabytes of audio samples. so, how can colossus be loaded into kompakt? the solution is simple, colossus is supplied with a 'main.kom' file which you can load into kompakt; this file contains the kompakt installation parameters for colossus, and is a 'loader' for colossus. (it's not a stand-alone installer for colossus but it is a mere 1,090kb file). second, how do you make sure that you only have the sounds you want to use? the colossus sample library is divided into 'branches', with each branch containing a collection of sounds related to one specific instrument or style of music. for example, the 'guitar' branch contains the sampled sounds from the stratocaster, telecaster, les paul and bass guitar, while the 'classical' branch contains the sampled sounds from the stradivarius violin, the j.s. rousseau cello, the strigency harp, the besonon contrabass and the besonon or montavina harpsichord. although colossus is supplied with a number of instruments and styles of music, the majority of the sample sets are not complete ensembles - the sampled instruments rarely include a full complement of string, brass and woodwind players. however, the sample sets do contain a number of full-sounding instrumental ensembles, providing more than enough material for a wide range of genres.

this is all very well, but how does colossus sound? to answer that question, i've only used a small selection of the available instruments and styles. my first impressions of the 'sitar' samples were particularly favourable. the sampled sitar has a plucky and percussive character and the

instrument was clearly captured with a wide-frequency response. i was also impressed by the broad variety of different styles of indian music represented in the sample set. the instrument is, however, somewhat basic and lacks the crisp, clean resonance of more modern instruments such as the violin. for those users wanting an offline

version of colossus, both the dfd and wav (wave) versions of the sound set can be obtained direct from east west. after downloading, the files can be installed within kompakt and the process of loading the sounds is now, at least, a simple matter of pressing the 'load' button. as a final note, east west claim that the audio of colossus is

taken directly from the kontakt player. i was a little sceptical of this and, given the size of colossus, i wondered whether this made any difference to the sound quality but it was, in fact, one of the most pleasing aspects of the sound set. i've included a small example of the sounds in the player below (click to open in a new window).

so, there you have it -
colossus is certainly an
impressive set of gm
sounds and if you're
looking for a new set of
sounds for your kontakt
player then i can
recommend this east west
product. i'll be interested
to see how the creators
update the product over
the coming months.
